ENTRY ON REHEARING

The Commission finds:

- (1) On April 6, 2000, the Commission issued a Finding and Order adopting amendments to the rules for long-term forecast reports.
- (2) On May 1, 2000, Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company (CG&E) filed an application for rehearing to that order.
- (3) On May 8, 2000, Ohio Power and Columbus Southern Power companies (AEP) and FirstEnergy Corp. (FirstEnergy) filed for rehearing in this case.
- (4) The Commission finds that the application for rehearing filed by CG&E should be granted for the limited purpose of allowing the Commission additional time in which to consider the issues raised on rehearing and so that the applications for rehearing filed by AEP and FirstEnergy can be considered at the same time.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the application of CG&E for rehearing of the Commission's April 6, 2000, order in this case is granted for the limited purpose of allowing the Commission additional time in which to consider the issues raised on rehearing. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served on all parties of record.
