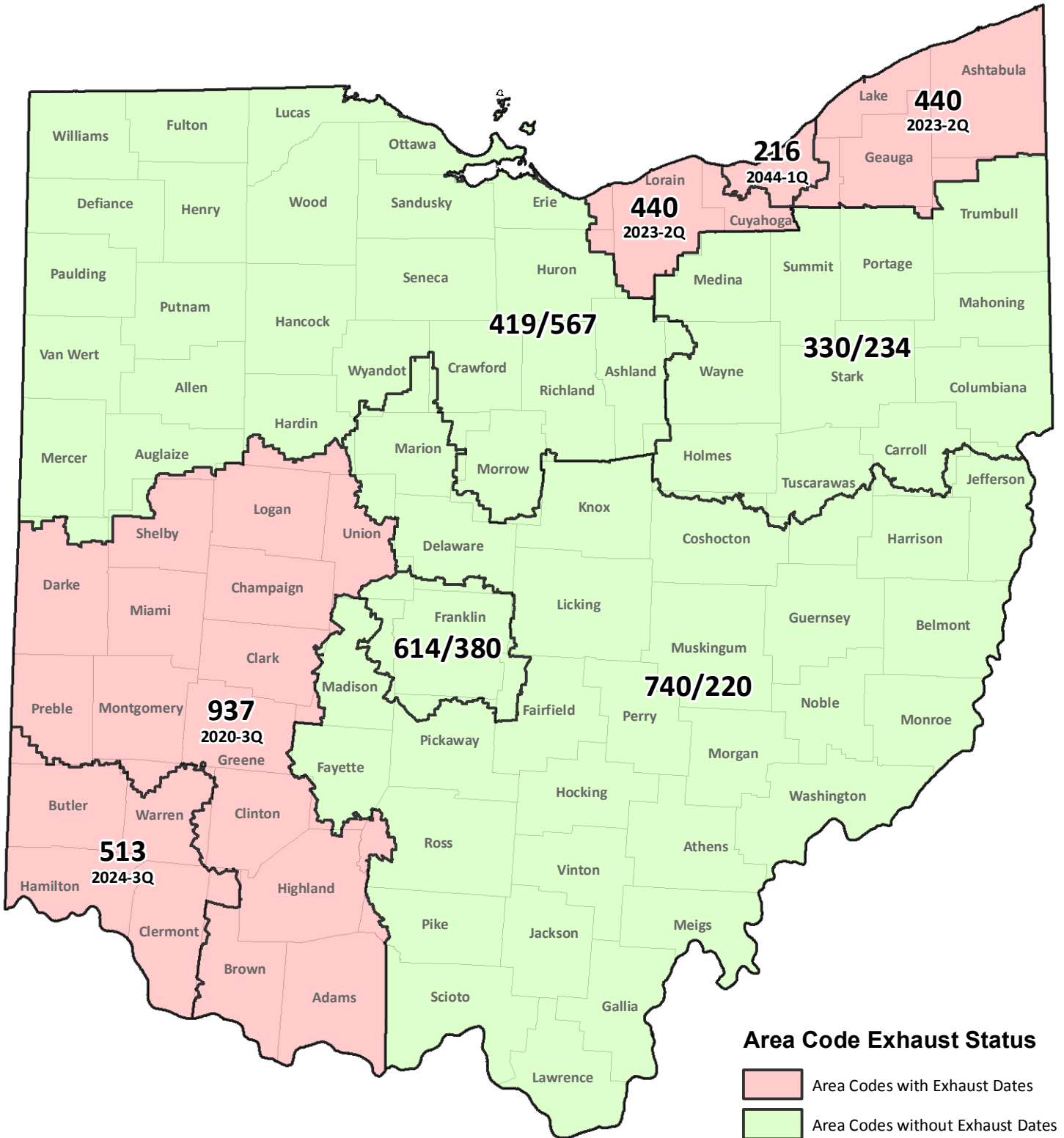




Telephone Area Code Exhaust Dates



Notes: The PUCO maintains area code boundaries. Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 4927.04(C) and federal law grant the Commission authority for the administration of telephone numbers and number portability. An area code reaches "exhaust" after assigning nearly all of the telephone prefixes, or first three digits, within that area code. The North American Numbering Plan Administration (NANPA) provides the exhaust dates as part of a semi-annual report produced in April and October called the NPA Exhaust Analysis. For all NANPA Exhaust analyses, projections beyond 30 years do not include a date. The current exhaust date projections come from the October 2017 NPA Exhaust Analysis and may change.
