



If the Commission makes any substantive changes to the rules on rehearing, another 30 day rehearing period is triggered with a 30 day decision period. JCARR has requested that no rules be sent to it until all rehearing requests have run their course.

Rule reviews occur every five years. Additionally, once a bill is signed by the governor and becomes effective, the PUCO may begin working on proposed rules related to the new law enacted. The PUCO begins the rules process by informally gathering input from stakeholders through a workshop.

This is a typical timeline for rule-making. The PUCO may lengthen or shorten the comment time frames on a case-by-case basis.
