Resolution Number 07-03

A Resolution Adopting Operating Standard 07-03

WHEREAS, Section 4931.68 of the Ohio Revised Code grants authority to the Ohio 9-1-1 Council to establish nondiscriminatory, competitively neutral, and uniform technical and operational standards for the 9-1-1 system in Ohio.

WHEREAS, the Ohio 9-1-1 Council believes it is imperative to establish a uniform operating standard for the processing of calls related to missing and/or sexually exploited children across Ohio.

WHEREAS, Operating Standard 07-03 is a recognized industry standard developed by a committee consisting of members of the Association of Public Safety Communications Officers, National Academies of Emergency Dispatch, National AMBER Alert Initiative, National Center for Missing & Exploited Children, and National Emergency Number Association.

IT IS, THEREFORE,

RESOLVED, That Operating Standard 07-03 is adopted as the recognized method of processing a call related to missing and/or sexually exploited children in the State of Ohio. It is, further,


RESOLVED, That, in accordance with Section 4931.68 of the Ohio Revised Code, each Public Safety Answering Point receiving wireless 9-1-1 calls in the State of Ohio is hereby directed to implement Operating Standard 07-03 into their operating practices and procedures. It is, further,

RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution and Operating Standard 07-03 be served upon each County 9-1-1 Coordinator within the State of Ohio for distribution to each Ohio public safety answering point.


